# Signatures on a Consent Form

This document is designed to explain how signatures operate on a consent form developed in RSS.

Effective as of 02/09/2024.

**Effective February 2024**, there will only be one **green plus** statement available to select under “Documentation of informed consent”.

**NOTE:** when using a NARRATIVE consent form template, the green plus will not appear and the statements will all be added automatically.

Documentation of informed consent

 You are deciding whether to be in this research study. Signing means that:

- You have read and understood this consent form.
- You have had the consent form explained to you.
- You have been given a copy of The Rights of Research Subjects You have had your questions answered.
- You have decided to be in the research study.
- You have been told you can talk to one of the researchers listed below on this consent form if you have any questions during the study.
- You will be given a signed and dated copy of this consent form to keep.

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The signature line of the person obtaining consent and the authorization statement that precedes it will automatically populate on the consent form and no longer needs to be selected as it had prior to February, 2024.

**NOTE:** this does NOT apply if you select that the consent will NOT be signed.

In this section, you will select WHO will be signing the informed consent form (ICF). The person obtaining consent will always remain checked, but the rest are optional.

**NOTE:** you will always want to include the subject even if the subject won't be signing (child, decisionally-impaired, etc).

This allows the subject's name to appear on the ICF and give the option in e-signature to include the subject's name.

**NOTE:** select parent, LAR, and/or witness as it applies appropriately to each specific study.

If not selected, the signature lines will not appear on the ICF or appear as options for e-signature.
